

WATERCOLOR FLOWERS VINES & FLOWERS PLANTER

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

MB1557 Textured Planters
Fan Brush
Liner Brush
Detail Brush
Small Brush
Pencil or Water-Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 18 – Pumpkin Pie CMM 92 – Ghostly Grape CMM 47 – Deep Sea CMM 19 – Banana Boat CMM 29 – Grasshopper CMM 66 – Pink Berry



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Water down Grasshopper with 50% water to 50% paint.
- 2. Use a liner brush to apply vines to the center section of the planter, with 2 coats of the watered-down Grasshopper paint, allowing the lines to overlap.
- 3. Create the leaves with a detail brush and 2 coats of watered-down Grasshopper paint.
- 4. Use a detail brush to apply little flowers among the vines with 2 coats of the desired paint.
- 5. Apply the center of the flower by dipping the handle of the detail brush into the paint, and tap it on the center of the flower.
- 6. Water down Pumpkin Pie with 50% water and 50% paint.
- 7. Paint the inside of the planter with 2 coats of the watered-down Pumpkin Pie using a fan brush.
- 8. Use a small brush to apply 2 coats of watered-down Pumpkin Pie to the rim of the planter.

TIPS

- By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
- If desired, use a pencil or water-based marker to sketch on the flowers.
